AN ACT RELATIVE TO SCHOOL BUILDING ASSISTANCE FOR CONSTRUCTION
OF NEW SCHOOLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 6 of chapter 645 of the acts of 1948, as amended by
2 chapter 346 of the acts of 1954, is hereby further amended by
3 striking out the last sentence and inserting in place thereof the
4 following sentence: — The said commission may, if it is satisfied
5 that the plans so submitted are satisfactory with respect to site, type
6 and adequacy of the proposed construction for an approved school
7 project in a regional school district and in the best interest of the
8 respective towns, and the expenses so incurred are reasonable,
9 certify to the comptroller for payment to such regional school
10 district such amount, not exceeding such expenses, as it may deem
11 proper, and the state treasurer shall forthwith make the payments
12 so certified from any funds appropriated therefor; provided, how-
13 ever, that no new school construction plans shall be approved nor
14 money expended hereunder unless such plans provide for a sloped
15 roof.
