AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF WORCESTER TO ESTABLISH A SCHEDULE OF FINES FOR VIOLATIONS OF CITY ORDINANCES AND REGULATIONS PROHIBITING DUMPING OF TRASH AND RUBBISH ON CITY OWNED LANDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the city of Worcester
2 acting through its city council may by ordinance establish fines and
3 penalties for violations of ordinances relating to illegal dumping,
4 abandonment of automobiles, and the disposal of trash, refuse,
5 rubbish and debris, in an amount not to exceed two thousand
6 (\$2,000.00) dollars for each offense.
