AN ACT ALLOWING ROBERT BAKER TO BE ELIGIBLE TO TAKE THE NEXT OPEN COMPETITIVE EXAMINATION FOR POLICE OFFICER IN THE TOWN OF HOLBROOK.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any law or rule to the  
2 contrary regulating the maximum age of applicants for  
3 appointment as a police officer, Robert Baker shall be eligible to  
4 take the next open competitive entrance examination for police  
5 officer in the town of Holbrook and, provided he meets all other  
6 requirements, shall be eligible for certification and appointment  
7 as a police officer in the Town of Holbrook.
