1 *Ordered*, That the committee on Election Laws be authorized
2 to sit during the session and recess of the General Court for the
3 purpose of making an investigation and study of the nominating
4 of candidates for governor and lieutenant governor in groups,
5 including the current House document number 5061.

6 Said Committee shall report the results of its investigation and
7 study, and its recommendations, if any, to the General Court,
8 together with the drafts of legislation necessary to carry such
9 recommendations into effect by filing the same with the clerk of
10 the House of Representatives on or before the last Wednesday
11 in December, nineteen hundred and eighty-six.
