6 most recently revived and continued by the provisions of an order
7 5854 of 1985 adopted by the House of Representatives on March
8 twenty-fifth and by the Senate on April twenty-third, shall in the
9 course of its investigation and study, consider the subject matter
10 of current House document numbered 8, relative to providing for
11 the retirement for disability of Frank J. Olivo for injuries
