7 time the results of its investigations and study and its recommenda-
8 tions, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry
9 its recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk
10 of the House of Representatives on or before the first Wednesday
11 of December, nineteen hundred and eighty-six.
