AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE STATE SECRETARY TO PERMIT THE SOLEMNIZATION OF A CERTAIN MARRIAGE.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to
2 defeat its purpose, which is to immediately authorize the
3 solemnization of a certain marriage, therefore it is hereby declared
4 to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation
5 of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of section thirty-nine of chapter
2 two hundred and seven of the General Laws, the state secretary
3 may authorize, in the manner set forth under said section thirty-
4 nine, the solemnization of a marriage by Judge Damon Kieth, as
5 he is a Judge sitting in the state of Michigan, of Lani Guinier and
6 Nolan Bowie at Oak Bluffs on August second, nineteen hundred
7 and eighty-six, and the state secretary shall issue to Judge Damon
8 Kieth in his capacity as aforesaid a certificate of such
9 authorization.
