2 retirement established under the provisions of an order adopted by
3 the House of Representatives on the fourteenth day of April, nine-
4 teen hundred and eighty-two, and by the Senate on the twenty-
5 seventh day of April, nineteen hundred and eighty-two (see 5865 of
6 1982) and most recently revived and continued by the provisions of
7 an order 5854 of 1985 adopted by the House of Representatives on
8 March twenty-fifth and by the Senate on April twenty-third, shall
9 in the course of its investigation and study, consider the subject
10 matter of current House document 6222, relative to the mandatory
11 retirement age for certain public employees.
