AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING MOTOR VEHICLE INSURANCE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The seventh paragraph of section 113B of chapter 175 of the
- 2 General Laws, as appearing in the 1984 Official Edition, is hereby
- 3 amended by inserting after the second sentence the following
- 4 sentence: — In establishing the four or more comprehensive
- 5 claims totalling two thousand dollars or more, claims for damages
- 6 caused by acts of God shall be excluded.
