AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE EXPENDITURE OF DEFAULT FUNDS BY THE
MUNICIPAL PLANNING BOARDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 81U of chapter 41 of the General Laws, as appearing in
2 the 1984 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the
3 ninth paragraph the following paragraph: —

4 In any town which accepts the provisions of this paragraph, the
5 provisions of section fifty-three of chapter forty-four shall not
6 apply with respect to the proceeds of any such bond or deposit
7 and such proceeds may be expended by the planning board
8 without specific appropriation to meet the costs and expenses of
9 the town in completing the work as specified in the approved plan;
10 provided, however, that the prior approval of the planning board
11 must be given for the use of such proceeds and if such approval
12 is not given said proceeds shall be paid into the treasurer of the
13 town.
