AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF SALT STORAGE SHEDS BY CITIES AND TOWNS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 3 of Chapter 811 of the Acts of 1985 is
2 hereby amended by striking out clause (a) and inserting in place
3 thereof the following:

4 (a) a sum not to exceed seven million dollars for the acquisition
5 and improvement of maintenance sites, including the construction
6 of sanitary facilities, the erection of protective fences and the
7 construction of salt storage sheds; provided, however, that the
8 department shall make available to cities and towns a sum of six
9 million dollars for the construction of salt storage sheds.

1 SECTION 2. Said Chapter 811 is hereby further amended in
2 the first sentence of Section 9 by striking out the words "four
3 hundred and eighty-five million dollars" and inserting in place
4 thereof the words: — four hundred and eighty-nine million
5 dollars.
