AN ACT AMENDING RELATIVE TO HEALTH INSURANCE BENEFITS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 151A of the General Laws as most recently amended
- 2 by Chapter 208 of the Acts of 1984 is hereby further amended
- 3 in Section 71G (a) by inserting the following at the end of the first
- 4 paragraph:
- 5 or 3) Until June 30, 1986 the individual was covered by a group
- 6 health insurance policy which had not been issued or subsequently
- 7 reviewed after January 1, 1985 and, therefore was not subject to
- 8 the provisions of Section 8 or Section 9 below.
