AN ACT RELATIVE TO ACTIVITIES NOT PROHIBITED ON SUNDAY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 6 of Chapter 136 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by striking out paragraph 50 and inserting in place thereof the
3 following paragraph: —

4 The keeping open of a store or shop and the sale at retail of
5 goods therein, but not including the retail sale of goods subject
6 to chapter one hundred and thirty-eight, and the performance of
7 labor, business, and work directly connected therewith on
8 Sunday; provided, however, that this exemption shall not apply
9 to any legal holiday as defined in this chapter.
