AN ACT RELATIVE TO SERVICE CHARGES ON TICKET SALES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The first paragraph of section 185D of chapter 140 of the 1984
- 2 Official Edition of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding
- 3 at the end of the first paragraph the following: —
- 4 The Seller shall be required to notify the purchaser at the time
- 5 the order is taken that all service charges may not be refunded
- 6 if the event is cancelled or postponed.
