AN ACT MAKING CERTAIN CORRECTIVE CHANGES TO THE DRUNK DRIVING LAW.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 24D of said chapter 90, as most recently  
2 amended by section 6 of chapter 373 of the acts of 1982 is hereby  
3 amended by inserting after the second paragraph the following  
4 new paragraph: —

5 Any case wherein there is no conviction and which is disposed of  
6 under the provisions of this section, except a case wherein the  
7 person is not found guilty, shall not be eligible to be sealed for a  
8 period of six years notwithstanding the provisions of section 100C  
9 of chapter two hundred and seventy-six.

1 SECTION 2. Said section 24D of said chapter 90, as so  
2 amended, is hereby further amended by adding to the fifth para-  
3 graph the following sentence: —

4 The director shall meet at least quarterly with a committee of  
5 judges to be appointed by the chief justice of the district court  
6 division, with one judge to be selected by the chief justice of the  
7 Boston Municipal Court, to discuss the scope and quality of said  
8 driver alcohol education programs.

1 SECTION 3. Paragraph (a) of Section 24G of said chapter 90,  
2 as appearing in section 9 of chapter 373 of the acts of 1982, is

3 hereby amended by inserting after the word "sentence" in line 21,  
4 the words: —  
5 until such person has served at least one year of such sentence.

1 SECTION 4. Section four of this act shall take effect as of  
2 September first, nineteen hundred and eighty-two.
