AN ACT INCREASING THE PENALTY FOR OPERATING AN UNINSURED MOTOR VEHICLE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 34J of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by chapter 282 of the acts of 1959, is hereby further
3 amended by striking out the words, "not less than one hundred nor
4 more than five hundred dollars" and inserting in place thereof the
5 words, "no less than three hundred nor more than one thousand
6 dollars."
