

By Mr. Buell, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 252) of Robert C. Buell for legislation relative to the issuance of licenses to operate certain private business schools in the Commonwealth. Education.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ISSUANCE OF LICENSES TO OPERATE CERTAIN PRIVATE BUSINESS SCHOOLS IN THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 75D of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking
2 out section 2, as most recently amended by Chapter 360 of the acts
3 of 1982, and inserting in place thereof the following section:

4 Section 2. No private business school shall be operated in the
5 Commonwealth unless licensed by the Commissioner of Educa-
6 tion, hereinafter referred to in this chapter as the Commissioner.
7 The fee for the issuance of a license to operate a private business
8 school and the fee for each renewal thereof shall be determined
9 annually by the Commissioner of Administration under the provi-
10 sion of section three B of chapter seven. This section shall not
11 apply to any private business school which charges tuitions not
12 exceeding three hundred dollars per student in any year; provided,
13 however, that such private business schools must comply with the
14 bonding provisions of section fourteen of this chapter and the
15 provisions relating to personal service contracts contained in sec-
16 tion thirteen K of chapter two hundred fifty-five.
