By Mr. Kirby, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 304) of Edward P. Kirby for legislation to prohibit the Rate Setting Commission from approving retroactive tuition increases for private schools serving Chapter 766 students. Education.

AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE MASSACHUSETTS RATE SETTING COMMISSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regula-
- 2 tion to the contrary, the Massachusetts Rate Setting Commis-
- 3 sion is hereby prohibited from approving retroactive tuition
- 4 increases for private schools serving chapter 766 students.
- 5 Further, said commission shall establish tuition rates by March
- 6 first of each year for the following fiscal year.
