RESOLUTIONS MEMORIALIZING THE CONGRESS AND PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES RELATIVE TO THE INTERVENTION IN AND MILITARY AID TO CENTRAL AMERICA.

1 *Whereas*, The referendum question, contained in the following
2 Resolve, on United States policy toward Central America was
3 approved in all thirty-nine representative districts in which it
4 appeared by a cumulative margin of two hundred and sixty-one
5 thousand four hundred and sixty-five to one hundred and twenty-
6 four thousand one hundred and twenty-two; therefore be it

7 *Resolved*, That the Massachusetts General Court calls upon
8 the Congress and the President of the United States to
9 immediately withdraw all troops and advisors from El Salvador
10 and Honduras; stop any and all military aid to El Salvador,
11 Honduras, and Guatemala; and stop any and all aid to the forces
12 fighting to overthrow the government of Nicaragua; and to direct
13 funds now used for such purposes to the domestic economy to
14 create jobs and improve services;

15 *Resolved*, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to the
16 presiding officer of each branch of Congress, the President of the
17 United States, and the Massachusetts Congressional delegation.
