AN ACT RELATIVE TO FUNERAL PROCESSIONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule, or regulation  
2 to the contrary, the Board of Registration in Embalming and  
3 Funeral Directing is hereby authorized and directed to  
4 promulgate rules and regulations requiring funeral directors to use  
5 flags on the bumpers of all motor vehicles participating in a  
6 funeral procession.
