AN ACT RELATIVE TO SUBDIVISION RULES AND REGULATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 81Q of chapter 41 of the General Laws, as appearing in
2 the 1984 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting in line 35,
3 after the word, "town," the following sentence: — "For the pur-
4 pose of the preceding sentence, the acceptance of a way or ways by
5 a city or town, which have been regularly used by the public for a
6 period not less than thirty years, prior to the acceptance of said
7 way or ways by said city or town, shall not constitute the standards
8 and criteria commonly applied by said city or town to the laying
9 out, construction, alteration or maintenance of its publicly
10 financed ways."
