AN ACT TO ESTABLISH EQUITY FOR GENERAL RELIEF RECIPIENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1 of chapter 117 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by adding the following paragraph after the second
3 paragraph: —

4 The total budget for each eligible recipient before taking into
5 account any available income or resources, shall be equal to
6 the total budget provided pursuant to section two of chapter
7 one hundred and eighteen to an assistance unit of equal size,
8 before taking into account any available income or resources.
