AN ACT REQUIRING INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR ELECTRICAL CONTRACTORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law
2 to the contrary, no permit for the performance of electrical
3 work pursuant to chapters 141 and 143 of the Massachusetts
4 laws, shall be issued by any city or town unless the licensee
5 provides proof of liability insurance, including "completed
6 operation" coverage, which has been issued by an insurance
7 company licensed to do business within the Commonwealth.
