AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT OF THE TOWN OF WARE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 5 of the Acts of 1981 is hereby amended
2 by deleting in lines 13, 14, 15, and 16, the following words: "the
3 nine-member revitalization committee, which was created by the
4 October twenty-ninth, nineteen hundred and seventy-nine special
5 town meeting,"

1 SECTION 2. Paragraph (b) of Section 6 of said Chapter is
2 hereby amended by inserting after the word "congested" in line 3,
3 the word "decadent".

1 SECTION 3. Section 7 of said Chapter is hereby amended by
2 deleting the last paragraph.

1 SECTION 4. Said Chapter 511 is hereby amended by inserting
2 after Section 7 the following section: —

3 Section 7A. The town shall establish a community develop-
4 ment advisory committee consisting of seven residents of the town
5 to advise the selectmen and the authority on matters relative to
6 community development as set forth in this act. The moderator
7 shall appoint members to the community development advisory
8 committee from a list of names submitted to him by the selectmen.
9 The rules governing the composition of the committee shall be
10 established by the committee and the authority subject to the

11 approval of the selectmen except that the committee shall be
12 representative of disparate social and economic segments of the
13 town considering such factors as income, ethnic heritage, racial
14 origin, age and sex. This committee shall also serve to fulfill state
15 and federal laws or regulations relative to citizen participation
16 including advisory boards, project committees, or similar entities
17 provided that the committee's composition shall be in conform-
18 ance with such laws or regulations as may be imposed from time
19 to time. No member of the authority shall serve concurrently as
20 a member of said committee.

1 SECTION 5. Section 9 of said Chapter is hereby amended by
2 inserting after the word "such" in line 7, the words "contract to
3 which the Town or the authority is subject. Such contract may
4 further provide that, in case of"
