AN ACT LIMITING LIABILITY OF THE OWNER OF A FARM WHILE CONDUCTING A SO-CALLED "PICK-YOUR-OWN" OPERATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the
- 2 owner of a farm who allows any person to enter his property for
- 3 the purpose of harvesting a crop, including Christmas trees, for an
- 4 established price under a so-called "pick-your-own" agreement,
- 5 shall not be liable if, during the normal course of the harvesting
- 6 said person is injured.
