AN ACT TO ADEQUATELY STAFF THE BOSTON MUNICIPAL COURT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 62A of Chapter 218 is hereby amended by striking
2 therefrom all the language in said section and inserting the following: —

3 Section 62A. In the municipal court of the city of Boston the
4 court officers appointed shall not exceed thirty-two, one of whom
5 shall be designated by the administrative justice as chief court
6 officer of said court for criminal business, and two as assistant
7 chief court officers of said court, and one of whom shall be
8 designated by said administrative justice as chief court officer of
9 said court for civil business, and one assistant chief court officer of
10 said court for civil business.
