AN ACT TO PROTECT FARMERS AND THE GENERAL CITIZENRY FROM CERTAIN DANGEROUS ANIMALS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation
- 2 to the contrary, the hunting of coyotes or coy-dogs shall be legal
- 3 throughout the year.
