AN ACT RELATIVE TO APPOINTED TOWN OFFICERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 41 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 after section 1A the following section: —
- 3 Section 1B. In any town that votes to accept Section 1B of
- 4 Chapter 41 by majority vote at an annual town meeting, the Board
- 5 of Selectmen shall name all appointed town officers one month
- 6 before the annual town election. All appointed town officers, 7 including election officers and poll workers, shall be appointed
- 8 for a three-year term, which shall expire on the same date as that
- 9 set by town by-laws for elected officials.
