### AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF TOWN ACCOUNTANTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Amend section fifty-five of chapter forty-one by adding the
- 2 following sentence: — “Any town accountant/city auditor shall
- 3 be prohibited from holding any other office where he or she
- 4 would be involved in the receipt or disbursement of money,
- 5 except grandfathering those currently holding such office and
- 6 performing such duties at the time of enactment of this bill.”
