AN ACT REQUIRING DRIVER-ALCOHOL TRAINING AS A PREREQUISITE FOR APPLICATION FOR A DRIVER'S LICENSE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The first paragraph of section 8 of chapter 90 of the General
2 Laws, as appearing in chapter 361 of the acts of 1973, is hereby
3 amended by striking out the second sentence and inserting in place
4 thereof the following sentence: — Each applicant shall submit
5 with his application a birth, baptismal or school certificate or
6 other satisfactory evidence of his age as the registrar may require;
7 and a certificate of completion of a driver alcohol education
8 program which shall be established by the registrar of motor
9 vehicles.
