AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE STATE GUARD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any other general or special law to the con-
2 trary, veterans of the Massachusetts State Guard who are
3 employed by the commonwealth or by any city or town shall
4 receive the same retirement benefits as employees in Group 2
5 under the Massachusetts retirement system.
