By Mr. Doris, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1279) of Francis D. Doris for legislation relative to retirement credit for military service. Public Service.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO RETIREMENT CREDIT FOR MILITARY SERVICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, a
2 person who is a member in service of a retirement system under the
3 provisions of chapter thirty-two of the General Laws shall be
4 credited for retirement purposes with time spent in the military
5 service of the United States; provided however, that such credit
6 shall not exceed four years; provided further, that prior to the
7 retirement of such person and for a period of time equal to such
8 credit such person shall contribute to the retirement fund of such
9 system, a sum equal to the percentage currently contributed to the
10 retirement system by said person, payable in equal monthly install-
11 ments; and provided further, that such person was honorably
12 discharged from such military service.
