

By Mr. LoPresti, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1376) of Michael LoPresti, Jr., for legislation to authorize the Division of Capital Planning and Operations to sell and convey a certain parcel of land in the city of Cambridge under the control of the Metropolitan District Commission. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DIVISION OF CAPITAL PLANNING AND OPERATIONS TO SELL AND CONVEY A CERTAIN PARCEL OF LAND IN THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE UNDER THE CONTROL OF THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The division of capital planning and operations is hereby autho-
2 rized in the name of and on behalf of the commonwealth, to sell and
3 convey by quitclaim deed, approved as to form by the attorney
4 general, a certain parcel of land located on Industrial Park Road in
5 the city of Cambridge under the control of the metropolitan district
6 commission and presently used for highway purposes, subject to
7 the provisions of chapter seven of the General Laws, and any other
8 acts or amendments thereto, and any additional terms and condi-
9 tions as the division of capital planning and operations may pre-
10 scribe in consultation with the commission. Said land is shown as
11 Lot 1E on a plan entitled "Subdivision Plan of Land in Cambridge,
12 MA., Middlesex County" dated August 14, 1984, Survey of Engi-
13 neers of Boston and more particularly bounded and described as
14 follows:

15 SOUTHEASTERLY By Lot 1A as shown on said plan, 91.92
16 feet;

17 SOUTHWESTERLY By Lot 1B as shown on said plan, 4.91
18 feet;

19 NORTHWESTERLY Again by Lot 1B as shown on said plan,
20 91.79 feet.

21 Said Lot 1E contains 225 square feet more or less according to
22 said plan.
