AN ACT TO REQUIRE FILED SUB-BIDDERS TO SHARE IN THE REQUIREMENTS FOR MINORITY AND WOMEN BUSINESS ENTERPRISES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1     Insert in Chapter One Hundred and Forty-Nine, Section Forty-  
2 Four F in subsection (1) following the third paragraph the  
3 following new paragraph: —

4     Every separate Section of the specifications required by the  
5 provisions of this Section shall include the percentage requirement  
6 for Minority Business Enterprise (MBE) participation and for  
7 Women Business Enterprise (WBE) participation contained in the  
8 contract. Such percentage objective shall apply equally to each  
9 subcontractor and class of work listed under Section Forty-Four  
10 F. Regulations governing this requirement shall be issued by the  
11 Division of Capital Planning and Operations and shall be  
12 administered by the state agency under whose responsibility the  
13 contract subject to Section Forty-Four F is being performed.
