AN ACT RELATIVE TO EXTRA WORK OR MATERIALS, ORDERS AND CLAIMS
IN PUBLIC CONTRACTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section twenty A of chapter twenty-nine of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by striking out the words "five thousand" as they
3 appear in line nine, and inserting the words, "twenty-five
4 thousand."
