By Mr. Reilly, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1560) of Martin T. Reilly for legislation to provide for reductions in the taxation of interest and dividends of persons age sixty-five and over. Taxation.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR REDUCTIONS IN THE TAXATION OF INTEREST AND DIVIDENDS OF PERSONS AGE SIXTY-FIVE AND OVER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Clause (6) subdivision (a) of subsection B of section 3 of
2 chapter 62 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inser-
3 ting after the words "Part B Gross Income", the following
4 sentence: — A deduction from Part B income, in addition to
5 that provided by the first sentence of this clause, of five hun-
6 dred dollars on income and dividends from savings deposits,
7 savings accounts, shares including term and time deposits of
8 share savings accounts for persons age sixty-five and older
9 residents of Massachusetts. For married couples age sixty-five
10 or older this additional deduction shall be in the amount of one
11 thousand dollars.
