RESOLVE THAT CERTAIN SPECIAL COMMISSIONS ESTABLISHED BY THE LEGISLATURE BE REVIVED AND CONTINUED.

1 *Resolved*, That the special commissions established by chapter  
2 sixty-three of the resolves of nineteen hundred and seventy-three,  
3 section twelve of chapter three hundred sixty-two of the acts of  
4 nineteen hundred and seventy-five, chapter twenty-five of the  
5 resolves of nineteen hundred and seventy-nine, section twenty-two  
6 of chapter two hundred forty-one of the acts of nineteen hundred  
7 eighty-two, chapter seven of the resolves of nineteen hundred and  
8 eighty-three, item 0185-7803 of chapter two hundred eighty-nine  
9 of the acts of nineteen hundred and eighty-three and item 0185-  
10 7824 of chapter two hundred eighty-nine of the acts of nineteen  
11 hundred eighty-three are hereby revived and continued until the  
12 last Wednesday in December, nineteen hundred and eighty-six.
