Ordered, That the joint committee on Taxation sit during the recess of the general court for the purpose of studying the so-called "Subchapter S Corporation" to determine whether it would be applicable to the income tax on individuals and corporations. The committee shall file its report with the clerk of the House of Representatives and the clerk of the Senate by five o'clock post meridian on December 3, 1986.
