**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Six.

AN ACT MODIFYING THE REQUIREMENTS FOR WEARING PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR WHILE OPERATING A MOTORCYCLE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The last sentence of the first paragraph of section seven of  
2 Chapter 90 of the General Laws, as inserted by Chapter Thirteen  
3 of the acts of Nineteen Hundred and Sixty-Seven is hereby deleted  
4 and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:

5 Section 1. Every person under the age of twenty years or every  
6 person issued a learners permit for operation of motorcycle shall  
7 wear protective headgear conforming to such minimum standards  
8 of construction and performance as the Registrar may prescribe,  
9 unless said person has undergone a certified Motorcycle  
10 Education Course.

11 Section 2. The Registrar may at his discretion establish a  
12 program of education and training for motorcycle operators or  
13 adopt a program already in effect which may include but need  
14 not be limited to formal classroom instruction and roadway  
15 training. He may receive private or public grants, gifts, loans or  
16 other funds for this purpose and disperse the same as he deems  
17 necessary or appropriate according to law. No person who seeks  
18 or obtains a license to operate a motorcycle shall be required to  
19 participate in the said program of education and training as a  
20 condition to obtain or maintain such license.
