Norton for legislation to encourage alternate sources of energy and decrease dependence on oil; the petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 364) of Thomas C. Norton for legislation to encourage the use of solid waste as a source of energy; and the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 2399) of Roger R. Goyette for legislation to encourage the use of solid waste as a course of energy, reports the accompanying order (Senate, No. 1870).

1 *Ordered*, That the Committee on Energy be authorized to sit
2 during the session and during the recess of the General Court for
3 the purpose of making an investigation and study of the subject
4 matter of certain Senate documents numbered 361, 363 and 364
5 and a certain House document numbered 2399 relative to the use
6 of solid waste as a source of energy.

7 Said committee shall be provided with quarters in the State
8 House or elsewhere, may hold hearings, may travel within the
9 Commonwealth, and may expend for clerical and other services
10 such sums as may be appropriated therefor. Said committee shall
11 report to the General Court the results of its investigation and
12 study and its recommendations, if any, together with the drafts
13 of legislation necessary to carry such recommendations into effect
14 by filing the same with the Clerk of the Senate on or before the
15 last Wednesday in December, nineteen hundred and eighty-six.
