AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE OFFICE OF TREASURER-COLLECTOR OF TAXES IN THE TOWN OF ASHBURNHAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The office of Treasurer-Collector of Taxes of the
2 Town of Ashburnham is hereby established. Said Treasurer-
3 Collector of Taxes shall be appointed by the Town Administrator
4 with the approval of a two-thirds majority of the Board of
5 Selectmen for a term not to exceed three years and shall perform
6 all the duties hereinbefore performed by the Treasurer and Tax
7 Collector of said town and shall have such other powers and duties
8 as may from time to time be established. Said town may establish
9 by ByLaw such qualifications and terms of employment for such
10 office as it deems necessary and appropriate. Any vacancy in said
11 office shall be filled in like manner for the unexpired portion of
12 such term of office. Upon the appointment and qualification of
13 said Treasurer-Collector of Taxes, the terms of office of the
14 persons holding the offices of Treasurer and Collector of Taxes
15 shall terminate.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
