

By Mrs. Padula, a petition of Mary L. Padula and John F. MacGovern (by vote of the town) for legislation relative to licenses to sell alcoholic beverages in the town of Bolton. Government Regulations.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO LICENSES TO SELL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IN THE TOWN OF BOLTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any contrary provisions of
2 Chapter 138 of the General Laws, the local licensing authority of
3 the town of Bolton, as defined in section 1 of said Chapter 138,
4 is hereby authorized to issue to Rich House, Inc., a corporation
5 duly established by law in the Commonwealth and located in said
6 town, a restaurant license to sell, during the year nineteen hundred
7 eighty-six, all alcoholic beverages, to be consumed on its premises,
8 as provided in section 12 of said Chapter 138 and subject to all
9 other provisions of said chapter.

1 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding the vote of the Town of Bolton
2 cast at any previous biennial state election on the questions to have
3 been placed on the ballot for the town for such election under
4 the authority of section 11 of Chapter 138 of the General Laws,
5 or the additional subdivisions thereof provided by Chapter 706
6 of the Acts of 1967 and Chapter 850 of the Acts of 1969, the State
7 Secretary shall cause the following question to be placed on the
8 ballot for the Town of Bolton at each such future election:
9 (G) Shall a restaurant license be granted in the Town of Bolton
10 to Rich House, Inc., for the sale of all alcoholic beverages, to be
11 consumed on the premises?
12 If a majority of the votes cast in said town in answer to the above

13 subdivision (G) is in the affirmative, said town shall, irrespective
14 of the results of votes taken in answer to any other subdivision,
15 be taken to authorize for each of the two calendar years next
16 succeeding, the issuance of said restaurant license as defined and
17 limited in section 12 of said Chapter 138, for the sale in said town
18 of all alcoholic beverages to be consumed on the premises of Rich
19 House, Inc. subject to all provisions of said Chapter 138 except
20 as herein otherwise provided.

1 SECTION 3. The act shall take effect upon its passage.
