By Mr. Edward L. Burke, a petition of Edward L. Burke and Joseph M. Connolly for legislation to direct the Division of Capital Planning and Operations to sell and convey certain park land in the town of Framingham. State Administration.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Six.

AN ACT DIRECTING THE DIVISION OF CAPITAL PLANNING AND OPERATIONS TO SELL AND CONVEY CERTAIN PARK LAND IN THE TOWN OF FRAMINGHAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The division of capital planning and operations,
2 acting for and on behalf of the department of environmental man-
3 agement, is hereby authorized and directed to sell and convey to
4 William H. Pickett and Gertrude Pickett of 44 Lake road in the
5 town of Framingham a certain parcel of park land in the town of
6 Framingham by deed approved as to form by the attorney general.
7 Said land being that land ten feet beyond the lot line of said William
8 H. Pickett and Gertrude Pickett.

1 SECTION 2. In consideration for said conveyance provided in
2 section one the commonwealth may receive payment in a certain
3 parcel of land of equal or greater value and importance for conser-
4 vation purposes.
