AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE EXAMINATIONS OF ACCOUNTS OF CERTAIN COUNTY OFFICERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 45 of chapter 35 of the General Laws, as most recently  
2 amended by chapter 766 of the acts of 1971, is hereby further  
3 amended by striking the first sentence and inserting in place the  
4 following sentence: — The said director or his representative shall  
5 also visit, unannounced, at least once a year, all other county  
6 officers receiving money payable to the county, the recorder and  
7 all assistant recorders of the land court, registers of deeds, superin-  
8 tendent of training schools and of shops in houses of correction,  
9 and trustees and other officers receiving or disbursing funds of  
10 county tuberculosis hospitals, infirmaries or sanitarium, and shall  
11 examine their accounts and vouchers, and the items of receipts and  
12 expenditures.
