AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING BOXING OR SPARRING MATCHES OR EXHIBITIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 147, Section 37 of the General Laws, as
2 appearing in the 1986 Official Edition, is hereby amended by
3 adding the following sentence: — All boxers competing in the
4 Commonwealth shall submit to a medical test for drug usage, when
5 required by the Commission. The type of test may be either urinaly-
6 sis or blood testing.

1 SECTION 2. Chapter 147, Section 38 of the General Laws, as
2 appearing in the 1986 Official Edition, is hereby amended by
3 adding the following sentence: — The punching surface of all
4 boxing gloves shall be smooth, without seams, and of one-piece
5 construction.
