AN ACT PROHIBITING THE ISSUANCE OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR LICENSES TO PERSONS CONVICTED OF CERTAIN CRIMES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 138 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 1984
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after section 23B
- 3 the following section: —
- 4 Section 23C. No license or permit shall be issued under this
- 5 chapter to any person who has been convicted of homicide by a
- 6 motor vehicle a homicide by a motor vehicle while under the
- 7 influence of an intoxicating substance under the provisions of
- 8 section twenty-four G of chapter ninety nor to any corporation in
- 9 which such person is a stockholder.
