AN ACT RELATIVE TO A STABILIZATION AND RESTORATION PROJECT FOR THE POINT ALLERTON BLUFF IN THE TOWN OF HULL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law,
2 rule or regulation to the contrary, the Division of Waterways is
3 hereby authorized and directed to fund and implement a stabiliza-
4 tion and restoration project for Point Allerton Bluff in the Town of
5 Hull, or take any other action relative thereto. And furthermore
6 that the sum of \$300,000 be appropriated for the purpose of engi-
7 neering, design and environmental evaluation.
