RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE FEASIBILITY OF TRANSFERRING THE WELFARE SYSTEM FROM THE STATE TO THE SEVERAL CITIES AND TOWNS.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three
2 members of the senate, five members of the house of
3 representatives, the commissioner of public welfare or his
4 designee, and seven persons to be appointed by the governor, two
5 of whom shall be present or former recipients of the benefits of
6 the welfare system, is hereby established for the purpose of making
7 an investigation and study of the feasibility of transferring the
8 administration of the welfare system from the state to the several
9 cities and towns.
