

# HOUSE . . . . . No. 658

By Mr. Doyle of Boston, petition of Charles Robert Doyle for legislation to provide for social security payments to be deducted from the gross receipts of certain elderly persons in determining the amount of total income in qualifying for real property tax abatements. Taxation.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR SOCIAL SECURITY PAYMENTS TO BE DEDUCTED FROM THE GROSS RECEIPTS OF CERTAIN ELDERLY PERSONS IN DETERMINING THE AMOUNT OF THEIR TOTAL INCOME IN QUALIFYING FOR REAL PROPERTY TAX ABATEMENTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Clause Forty-first of section 5 of chapter 59 of the General  
2 Laws, as appearing in the 1984 Official Edition is hereby amended  
3 by adding the following sentence: — In determining the gross  
4 receipt of any person otherwise eligible for an abatement under  
5 the provisions of this clause, any payments such person receives  
6 under the federal social security law shall be deducted from such  
7 gross receipts.
