AN ACT PROVIDING THAT ATHLETIC TRAINERS WORKING FOR SECONDARY SCHOOLS BE EXEMPT FROM LICENSURE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 112, Section 23A is amended by adding after the defini-
- 2 tion of "Athletic Trainer", the following sentence:
- 3 "In the event a secondary school is unable to hire an athletic
- 4 trainer, after diligent search, that school shall be allowed to
- 5 employ other people. Said person shall be under the direction of
- 6 a physician or dentist duly registered in the Commonwealth."
